



SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR 10/22 BARRELS

For maximum accuracy, free floated rifle barrels are generally regarded as the best. Although due to the weight of the 10/22 heavy bull barrels hanging on the aluminum action, it is recommended to slightly pressure bed the forward end of the bull barrel (about 2-3 pounds) for continued accuracy. Your new **Hogue O.M. Series™** stock has been designed with two internal adjustable “contact areas” (refer to drawing).

First, install your action with the screw fully tight. Examine the forward most area where the stock meets the underside of the barrel to see if the barrel floats or pressure beds. For most “average tolerance” rifle actions, the stock is best left as-is. Less pressure bed is achieved by filing some or all of the “contact areas” away. More pressure bed requires additional shimming to “contact areas”. Using this system, you will be able to easily custom float/bed your 10/22 rifle barrel.
